

injury and damage unless Defendant is temporarily restrained or enjoined, as more fully shown by Debtor's verified complaint and the testimony of the Debtor's representatives at the hearing on this matter.

Debtor shows that simultaneous with the filing of this Motion, the Debtor served a copy of this Motion and the verified complaint upon Defendant by personal service, first class mail and Federal Express, providing notice to the Defendant that it is seeking a temporary restraining order and/or preliminary injunction.

WHEREFORE, Debtor prays that this Motion be GRANTED and that the Defendant be temporarily restrained and enjoined as aforesaid, and that Debtor have such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
