Barbara Jape came to the Cherokee Family Violence Center seeking a Temporary Protective Order against her husband Daniel Lee Jape, the Respondent. The parties have been married for twenty one years and lived together for two years prior to their marriage. Their relationship yielded two common children including one minor child, Elizabeth Jape (W/F DOB 8/1/88.)

Petitioner indicates that she is the President of local company and that Respondent had been employed by this company. He was released from his service by the Board on November 3, 2005. "He is no longer an officer of the corporation, he no longer works there; we have paid him a salary for two years so he would stay away. I told him he could come back to work on a limited basis...Friday night I left and when I came back one of the doors to the server room had been taken off it's hinges, the door probably weighs 100 pounds. I told him he was terminated, not to come back on the property. He was verbally abusive to me. He said he would come after me with guns blazing. My daughter was in the parking lot and he peeled out in the car and almost hit her. At 9:30 last night he called me and said if I didn't give him what he wants I would be embarrassed in front of my employees. I knew we had changed the locks so I didn't believe him so I went up there. I thought he was outside of the building and hat he would break in and do damage to the building in some way. What he had done was change the lock on a back door and that is how he was accessing the building. He had said he was waiting for me, he would teach me a lesson, he would show me this unless I did what he wanted which was full access, he's rather a control freak. He was standing outside acting like he hadn't been in. I went in and realized that he had been inside because my desk was vacated. He said he had thrown everything else away. When I told him to get out he threw a chair at me. He grabbed me by the arm as I was turning to walk off from him. I got the words, you slut, you whore...he would take me down, he would take the company down, he would show me how bad it would get, I hadn't seen anything yet. I called the police and they came up...he had left by then."

"About 8:00 today he comes in like he owns the place, I asked him to please leave. He pushed past me and I said I was going to call the police, he laughed...he walked by my desk and threw down the hard drive and said he was going to use it against me. Cherokee County has the hard drive and they have proof that it was being accessed when I wasn't using it. I came in on several occasions and my email was opened up and there would be pictures of him and his girlfriend or pictures of multiple girls touching each other. They were all taken at 110 Wiley Bridge where we used to live for all of those years." Cherokee County Sheriff's Office personnel took Respondent into custody for Burglary and Computer Theft after the incident.

"Six weeks ago or something my daughter called hysterical because he was at the house and I wasn't there. He was climbing up under the deck which would
